

Senior Planning Associate

POSITION OVERVIEW

SV@Home is seeking a motivated, detail oriented, and driven candidate to support our planning and land use advocacy efforts. The Senior Planning Associate will work to develop and implement SV@Home's portfolio of land use campaigns as well as oversee planning policy. This position reports to the Deputy Director. Due to the current pandemic, this position will work remotely through the end of this calendar year.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Senior Planning Associate will be responsible for the following activities:

Policy and Advocacy

- Developing and implementing land use campaign strategies that achieve SV@Home's housing affordability goals through city and county area/specific plans in partnership with policymakers, city and county staff, and community members.
- Providing planning expertise in developing SV@Home policy recommendations and responses to General Plans, Housing Elements, Plan Bay Area, and the Regional Housing Needs Allocation process.
- Preparing recommendations to present to policymakers regarding development-related policies, regulations, ordinances, codes, and legislation at the local and State levels.
- Identifying and supporting community solutions to respond to outdated land use and housing
 policies and ordinances that have resulted in segregation and inequity.

Communication, Partnerships, and Engagement

- Testifying at public meetings and participating, as needed, on task forces and committees.
- Preparing comment letters and activating advocacy tools to engage members and community members
- Supporting efforts to change the conversation through social media, educational events, and other communication channels.
- Preparing blog posts and other written communication on land use and housing topics
- Cultivating and maintaining relationships with key partners including community-based organizations, landowners/developers, and other policy experts.

Supporting efforts to establish and maintain relationships with local elected officials and city staff.

EXPERIENCE, KNOWLEDGE, AND ATTRIBUTES

A competitive candidate will have the following experience and knowledge:

- A Bachelor's degree and a minimum of two years of experience in a land use planning field is required. A Master's Degree in Urban or Regional Planning can substitute for experience. Additional experience in a land use planning position can be substituted for the education requirement.
- A well-developed knowledge of local planning principles and practices. GIS skills are highly desired but not required.
- Familiarity with local government planning and development policies and understanding of planning regulations and codes.
- While not required, experience with housing and community development is a plus.
- Must possess excellent communications skills including outstanding writing and public speaking skills and familiarity with social media platforms.
- Must have a start-up attitude, be well organized at handling multiple tasks, work well in a team environment, and have the ability to work under minimal supervision.
- Must be flexible, nimble, and able to work well under pressure.

Compensation

- Starts at \$70,000 annual salary and will be based on experience and qualifications
- Competitive benefits package that includes medical, dental, vision, and life insurance; vacation and sick time; holidays plus a holiday office closure from December 25th through January 1st; a SIMPLE IRA retirement plan and employer match
