2021 NCAFPM Berry Williams Scholarship

Introduction/Description

The North Carolina Association of Floodplain Managers (NCAFPM) is pleased to announce its academic scholarship program for 2021. NCAFPM is a non-profit organization established in 1989 consisting of engineers, planners, geographers, land surveyors, zoning officials, emergency management coordinators, community officials, and private sector individuals. NCAFPM is dedicated to promoting public awareness of proper floodplain management, promoting professional development, enhancing information exchange, education and outreach, improving floodplain mapping, and reviewing and commenting on pertinent legislation such as the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The scholarship is named in honor of Berry Williams for his years of service as the State of North Carolina NFIP coordinator and assisting with the establishment and growth of NCAFPM from the association's beginning in 1989.

Two (2) \$1,250 scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving applicants based on the materials submitted with the application package. This is a one-time award for the selected applicants. Interested college students should review the eligibility requirements and submittals requested below.

Scholarship Type/Amount

• Two (2) scholarships are \$1,250 each and one-time awards.

Eligibility

- Minimum of GPA 3.0 on 4.0 scale
- Be a current full-time undergraduate student in a two- or four-year degree program at a college or
 university within the State of North Carolina, and within a program related to the disciplines of floodplain
 management (hydrology and storm water, engineering, planning and zoning, coastal management, hazard
 mitigation, emergency management, geography/GIS, surveying and UAS technology, etc.)

Additional Information

- Strongly encourage application submissions by students enrolled at Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) or Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) with a baccalaureate degree program.
- Strongly encourage application submissions by students enrolled at a technical community college with an associate degree program.

Submittal Requirements

- Completed application form
- Official copy of college transcript (to date)
- One letter of recommendation from a college advisor, academic instructor, or supervisor
- 500-word essay (see application form for more details)

Application Process and Deadline

- Submit all application materials electronically to the email address ncafpm-scholarships@ncafpm.org.
- Include the following in the subject line of the email with the scholarship application to assist NCAFPM with managing the submittals: "Your Name Application"
- All application documents must be submitted and received electronically by <u>January 31, 2021</u>.
