The City of Raleigh is hiring a Sustainability Analyst

The Sustainability Analyst will play a critical role in the success of sustainability efforts to benefit the Raleigh community and its more than 450,000 residents. The Office of Sustainability is responsible for leading organization and community-wide sustainability and climate efforts. This position will gather, support, analyze, educate, organize and report on a variety of issues in support of policy and programs, including but not limited to sustainability, climate, social and racial equity, resilience, energy, transportation, innovation, pilot projects, and more. The ideal candidate will possess an ability to be highly adaptable, flexible and positive; while remaining persistent, communicative and results driven.

The candidate will have demonstrated the skills of prioritizing projects and resources while communicating ideas, issues and results on a timely basis. We are looking for a detail-oriented, organized and highly skilled project manager to create and support Office processes and workflow, and to contribute to Raleigh's Community Climate Action Plan implementation efforts. The City of Raleigh values a diverse workplace that is representative of the residents we serve. Our search is inclusive of all interested applicants and we encourage those who may be under-represented in the field of sustainability to apply.

During the past 30 years, growth in Raleigh and the surrounding Research Triangle Region has consistently and significantly outpaced the nation. Fueled by an impressive mix of education, ingenuity and collaboration, North Carolina's capital city has become an internationally recognized leader in life science and technology innovation.

It also happens to be a really nice place to live. Raleigh frequently receives national recognition and has been listed as one of the fastest growing cities for many years. The City of Raleigh, founded in 1792, is the second largest city in North Carolina. The City of Raleigh is both the county seat of Wake County and the capital of North



Carolina. Raleigh covers an area of more than 146 square miles and is home to a growing and diverse population. The Raleigh-Cary metropolitan area includes a population of 1.24 million. Raleigh is known for its high quality of life for its residents. In the 2018 Citizen Satisfaction Survey, 89 percent of respondents were satisfied with Raleigh as a place to live – 37 percent higher than the national average.

The Office of Sustainability is working with the community on a Community Climate Action Plan (CCAP) focused on reducing greenhouse gas emissions, understanding the role of equity and the implications of climate change on vulnerable communities, and how the impacts of climate change affect overall community resiliency. Recognizing these challenges, in May 2019 the Raleigh City Council established a goal to reduce community GHG emissions in Raleigh 80% by the year 2050. The CCAP lays out a process toward that goal, and the Sustainability Analyst position is an exciting opportunity to join our team's efforts to engage on projects and with departments and the community in support of this work.
