In AY 21-22 our second-year students partnered with 10 communities across the state of North Carolina to develop their Comprehensive Plans and come into compliance with new state-wide regulations (Chapter 160-D of the North Carolina General Statutes). Students visited these communities, organized, and attended community meetings, and collaborated with partners in the community and the APA-NC Chapter to develop the final products. At the end of the year, each community partner evaluated the student's contributions and their readiness for professional practice in planning. The overwhelming majority of respondents agreed that the MCRP students had demonstrated the necessary skills for planning.
